




Characteristics of an Ideal Education System

(Source, Polling at K20 Council Meeting) N = [40-44]

- 1) Modular competency (outcomes) based
- 2) Supports multiple exit and entry paths to workplace
- 3) Student flexibility/choice in learning
- 4) Removal of barriers and access to learners
- 5) More effective teachers
- 6) Individual student records through student lifetime
- 7) Keeping pace with technology students use

Education Cycles with parallel virtual system




